TRANSPORT

All COP28 attendees are encouraged to use Dubai Metro to reach Expo 2020 Metro Station via the Metro Red Line, that connects DXB Airport, the main hotels and tourist attractions in Dubai. Dubai Metro Operational Hours are from 05:00 until 00:00. Plan your journey at https://www.rta.ae/wps/portal/rta/ae/public-transport/timetable#DubaiMetro

COP28 UAE will provide complimentary public transport throughout COP28 UAE for Blue Zone delegates. NOL Cards will be delivered during COP28 registration at Expo Site. COP28 UAE will also provide Shuttle Buses from Expo 2020 Metro Station to all Green Zone Gates.

Due to the limited car parking spaces in the Blue Zone, delegates are encouraged to use Dubai Metro and the Metro Park & Ride, located in Dubai's Metro.

TIPS ON DUBAI

What are the main languages spoken?

The official language is Arabic but English is widely spoken and written.

What is the currency & exchange rate?

The currency in the Dubai is the Dirhams (AED or DHS). The UAE Dirham is pegged to the USD. 1 USD is worth 3.653AED.

What clothes to pack?

Dubai is a cosmopolitan city and a diverse melting pot where almost all attires and cultural expressions are accepted.

Do I have to give Tip?

Tipping is customary in Dubai. It's common to leave a tip of around 10-15% in restaurants, and you may also tip taxi drivers and hotel staff.

How is the weather in Dubai?

The winter months last from October to May with temperatures ranging from 20–35°C.
